



## Daily Schedule

ALL ACTIVITIES AND TIMES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

08:00 am to 09:00 am	<p><b>Free Choice Activity Time</b> Children are free to choose from the prepared environment. Ground rules are stressed for the safety and well-being of each child. Promotion of math and language arts readiness skills.</p>
09:00 am to 09:30 am	<p><b>Morning Circle Time</b> Introduce the monthly themes; demonstrate new work jobs, stress child participation. Includes puppets, flannel board stories, movement, music, and books. The calendar, days of the week, months of the year, alphabet, and number charts are done in both Spanish and English.</p>
09:30 am to 09:45 am	<p><b>Snacks Time</b> A prepared snack is served.</p>
09:45 am to 10:30 am	<p><b>Montessori Work Time</b> Encourages self-directed learning, allowing children to choose activities from a prepared environment. During this time, teachers observe and guide without interruption, fostering independence and a love for learning in each child. The emphasis is on hands-on, experiential learning across various developmental areas. (Fine Motor Skills/Gross Moto Skills/Art and Craft)</p>
10:30 am to 11:00 am	<p><b>Special Activities</b> This involves dynamic elements such as science experiments, news sharing, and show-and-tell, fostering hands-on learning and communication skills. These sessions enhance curiosity and social development, creating engaging educational experiences for young children.</p>
11:00 am to 11:30 am	<p><b>Outside Play Time</b> Children are free to play outside</p>
11:30 am to 12:00 pm	<p><b>Lunch Time</b> Children bring a prepared lunch from home. This activity also builds social skills, manners, and independence. In warmer months lunch is served outside at the picnic benches.</p>
12:00 pm to 12:15 pm	<p><b>Story Time</b> Teachers read aloud to children, introducing them to literature, fostering language skills, and igniting a passion for storytelling and books. It creates a shared experience that promotes listening, imagination, and early literacy development.</p>
12:15 pm to 02:15 pm	<p><b>Nap Time</b> A sleeping cot and space are available for all full-time children. Two blankets and an (optional) pillow come from home and are taken home for weekly washing, Note: No child is forced to nap but needs to rest for at least an hour.</p>

02:15 pm to 02:45 pm	<b>Music and Movement</b> Involves rhythmic activities and dance, promoting physical coordination, creative expression, and social interaction among young children. It enhances sensory development and provides a fun, engaging way for kids to explore music and express themselves physically.
02:45 pm to 03:00 pm	<b>Snack</b> A prepared snack is served
03:00 pm to 03:30 pm	<b>Cultural Activates</b> These activities aim to foster an appreciation for different cultures, promoting global awareness and inclusivity. Every day, children are exposed to various subjects such as Botany, Zoology, Geography, History, and activities centered around giving back.
03:30 pm to 04:00 pm	<b>Enrichment Program</b> It's designed to enhance and broaden the educational experiences of young children beyond the basic subjects. These programs often incorporate a variety of stimulating activities, such as arts and crafts, music, physical education, and other hands-on learning opportunities. The goal is to provide children with a well-rounded educational experience that goes beyond the core curriculum, fostering their cognitive, social, emotional, and physical development.
04:00 pm to 04:30 pm	<b>Creative Active Circle Time</b> Music instruments, big books, library books, and group participation promote reading and listening skills
04:30 pm to 05:00 pm	<b>Outside Playtime</b> Children are free to play outside
05:00 pm to 06:00 pm	<b>Day Care Activities</b> Children are free to choose from the prepared environment, dance to music, or for a quiet activity of looking at a selected array of children's books.
